2016 DUST CONTROL PROGRAM

The RM of Reynolds will be accepting applications for dust control, on a **PRE-PAYMENT BASIS ONLY**, on municipal roads in front of residences in the Rural Municipality of Reynolds.

Ratepayers may obtain dust control on the basis of \$270.00 per application, which is 125 metres long. Orders and pre-payments are to be made to the Rural Municipality of Reynolds Administration Office by June 1st, 2016. The application will consist of 5 meters of road width x 125 meter strip. The area to be serviced must be staked out prior to application. Dust Control will be applied early June, 2016, weather permitting.

In the event of there not being sufficient requests for a truckload, payments will be refunded.

1. A charge of \$ 270.00 will be made for a single application of dust suppressant chemical at each site. The application of chemical shall consist of approximately 900 litres of product which will cover approximately 125 metres of roadway.
2. Set up start and stop flags for the operator of the truck.
3. A cheque or money order made payable to the RM of Reynolds in the amount of the prescribed fee must be attached to this application form.
4. The Municipality accepts no responsibility for the effectiveness of the dust suppressant chemical.
5. The Municipality reserves the right to perform such maintenance procedures as it deems necessary on the treated portions of the roadway. Although the Municipality will attempt to minimize any adverse effect of these operations on the treated portion of the roadway, the Municipality will not accept liability for any restoration required.
