BY-LAW NO. 10/12

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF REYNOLDS
TO AUTHORIZE THE ENTERING INTO OF AN AGREEMENT
WITH THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF LAC DU BONNET FOR
UTILIZING TRANSFER STATION #214

WHEREAS Part 8, Division I, Section 250(2) of the Municipal Act provides in part as follows:

250(2) Without limiting the generality of subsection (1), a municipality may for municipal purposes do the following:

(d) enter into agreements with one or more of the following regarding anything the municipality has power to do within the municipality:

(vi) another municipality in Manitoba or a municipality in another province;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient that an agreement be entered into with the Rural Municipality of Lac du Bonnet to utilize transfer station #214 situated in SW 22-13-9EPM;

AND WHEREAS the terms of the agreement have been negotiated and are contained in the agreement attached hereto as Schedule "A";


NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Rural Municipality of Reynolds enacts as follows:

1. That the entering into of the agreement attached hereto as Schedule "A" is hereby approved and authorized.
2. THAT the Reeve and the Acting Chief Administrative Officer of The Rural Municipality of Reynolds be and are hereby authorized and empowered to sign the Agreement and affix thereto the seal of the Municipality.
3. THAT this By-law shall expire on December 31st, 2014.
4. That By-law 2/11 is hereby rescinded

BETWEEN:

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF REYNOLDS
(hereinafter referred to as "Reynolds")
Party of the first part

and

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF LAC DU BONNET
(hereinafter referred to as "Lac du Bonnet")
Party of the second part

WHEREAS Lac du Bonnet operates and maintains a transfer station site on the SW ¼ of Section 22, Township 13, Range 9E more commonly known as the #214 Transfer Station;


AND WHEREAS some residents of Reynolds desire to utilize the #214 Transfer Station;

NOW THEREFORE THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH that, in consideration of the premises and the mutual covenants herein contained, the parties hereto covenant and agree as follows:


- 1) Lac du Bonnet shall permit residents of Reynolds to deposit bagged household waste at the #214 Transfer Station.
- 2) Reynolds agrees to supply punch cards to their residents authorizing entry and use of the #214 Transfer Station.
- 3) Reynolds agrees to collect all monies from residents at \$2.00 per bag or \$20.00 per ½ ton truck or small trailer load of household waste, and remit same to Lac du Bonnet.
- 4) Reynolds residents utilizing the Transfer Station must act in accordance with Lac du Bonnet's waste disposal by-law.
- 5) This Agreement expires on December 31st, 2014 unless terminated by either Party by serving the other Party with one month's notice of intention to withdraw from this Agreement.
