

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF REYNOLDS

BY – LAW NO. 7/16

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF REYNOLDS
TO ESTABLISH A FEE FOR SERVICE SCHEDULE FOR EMERGENCY
RESPONSE VEHICLES AND FIRE FIGHTERS

WHEREAS SUBSECTIONS 250(2)(c) of The Municipal Act provides as follows:

250(2) Without limiting the generality of subsection (1), a municipality may for municipal purposes do the following:

- (c) acquire, establish, maintain and operate services, facilities and utilities;

AND WHEREAS SUBSECTION 252(1)(a) of The Municipal Act provides as follows:

252(1) A municipality exercising powers in the nature of those referred to in clauses 250(2)(b), (c) and (e) may set terms and conditions in respect of users, including

- (a) setting the rates or amounts of deposits, fees and other charges, and charging and collecting them;

AND WHEREAS Reynolds Fire Department is paged to incidents on provincial roadways, involving people who do not contribute to the RM of Reynolds tax base but do use RM of Reynolds services;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and advisable to establish a fee for service schedule for emergency response vehicles and fire fighters when responding to emergencies involving non-residents or non-ratepayers.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Rural Municipality of Reynolds enacts as follows:

1. That a rate of \$350.00 per hour, minimum of three hours, be invoiced for call out of the Reynolds Fire Department pumper;
2. That a rate of \$250.00 per hour, minimum of three hours, be invoiced for call out of the Reynolds Fire Department tanker;
3. That a rate of \$250.00 per hour, minimum of three hours, be invoiced for call out of the Reynolds Fire Department rescue van.
4. That a rate of \$50.00 per hour, minimum of three hours, be invoiced for call out of Reynolds Fire Department ATV pumper.
5. That for fire calls that last longer than four hours, the appropriate meal allowance, as established by by-law for Council, will apply unless meals have been purchased on account or supplied on scene.
6. That Fire Fighters will be paid a minimum of three hours, for responding to a page, at a rate established by Resolution of Council.

AND BE IT RESOLVED that By-law 1/13 be rescinded in its entirety.
