

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF REYNOLDS BY-LAW 6-2024

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF REYNOLDS TO AUGMENT THE FIRE EQUIPMENT RESERVE ESTABLISHED BY BY-LAW NO. 3/06 AND TO ESTABLISH ANNUAL CONTRIBUTIONS THERETO

WHEREAS Section 168(1) of The Municipal Act L.M. 1996, c. 58 – Chap. M225 provides that a Council may by by-law establish a reserve fund for any general or specific purpose.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable and necessary to establish a Fire Equipment Reserve Fund for the general purposes of the Municipality and to make annual contributions thereto;

NOW THEREFORE be it hereby enacted as a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Reynolds as follows;

1. **THAT** a Special Rate be levied upon the assessed value of all ratable property liable thereto in the Rural Municipality of Reynolds sufficient to raise the following sums to be deposited to the Fire Equipment Reserve Fund in the year as identified.

2025 - \$50,000
2026 - \$50,000
2027 - \$50,000
2028 - \$50,000
2029 - \$50,000
