Yvonne Lewis asked about the timeline of the Prawda Water Plant. Cao and Reeve stated the process would start in 2022.

Yvonne Lewis asked about whose responsibility it is to hook up to line. Jeff Zalitach stated it is the homeowner's responsibility for any work done from line to the homes.

Taylor Plett asked if only one plumber would be used for hook ups. CAO and Reeve stated any plumber homeowner wants to hire is ok.

Andy Bannerman asked about timelines about how long their water would be off to connect to new system. CAO and Reeve stated it should not be a long process for the new connections to be done.




