1) Pineland Nursery

Discussion was held regarding the Province terminating the lease and the vacant Pineland nursery site. The Province hopes to know by mid Jan 2022 if the arrears owing can be settled private, will then meet with Wayne again at this time to move forward. RM of Reynolds will have involvement with potential RFPs and in the decision planning process for a new tenant. CAO to forward Wayne any inquiries for the lease, ideas etc.

2) Prawda Water Co-op

CAO to keep MLA informed as to the progress of this project.

3) Cell Towers (Ste Rita and Rennie)

CAO to send MLA contact information for the MTS project manager. He will reach out to ask for an updated timeline.

4) Broadband

MLA to inquire as to why Reynolds is not on the list of communities to be receiving service.

5) Building Sustainable Communities Grant

CAO to share this info with all community clubs and organizations. When an application is sent, copy to MLA office so he is aware of the project.
CAO to inquire whether the Reynolds Community Club would be eligible to apply for the grant to hook up to the new water treatment plant and copy MLA on the correspondence.

6) Falcon Lake/ #214 Transfer stations

CAO to forward MLA copies of the letter and response from Prov re: East Braintree residents' inquiry to utilize the Falcon Lake facility.

MLA cannot help with the Lac Du Bonnet Transfer station issues, CAO awaiting response from Lac Du Bonnet CAO.

7) Beausejour/Selkirk Hospitals

Discussion was held regarding staff shortages and possible solutions being worked on.
