WHITEMOUTH REYNOLDS NORTH WHITESHELL WASTE MANAGEMENT CHANGES

There are a few changes being implemented on **July 1, 2022:**

We will be tracking where our material comes from (which RM, not which household). **The QR card will be sent with your tax bill, USE YOUR DRIVER'S LICENCE I.D. UNTIL RECEIVED.**

Each household will receive a QR Card to show when using the Waste Management Site, **DO NOT DISCARD!**

Demolition Waste Fees have increased and you will be required to show a demolition permit.

All material from outside the catchment area will be paid for as demolition waste, at a higher rate than local demolition waste.

The QR Code will be linked to the RM Website for Waste Management and a debit machine will be added for ease of payment at the site. Please contact us if you require an additional QR card at 204-426-5305.

ONLY demolition waste needs to be paid for by the residents. Please do not share your cards with anyone as excess waste from outside our RM will cost all of our residents on taxes!

Recyclables earn money, waste costs money, please keep them separate. Corrugated cardboard and old newsprint recyclables have the best rates of return right now and we appreciate any sent in.

The site is part of Cleanfarms as well as other programs, and they collect hazardous materials such as batteries, oil, pesticides, fertilizer, baler twine as well as paint, aerosols, solvents, fluorescent lights, scrap metal and tires on rims.

FIRE PROTECTION AND SAFETY INFORMATION

Reynolds Fire Department suggestions for all municipal residents to follow to ensure effective fire protection and the safety of all residents and fire fighters.

1. Clean up your yard to prevent fueling fires that may occur.
2. Make emergency plans **BEFORE** emergencies happen. Have a personal plan.
3. Stay away from fire incident areas and surrounding roads.
4. If in an incident area, please follow directions from the Fire Department immediately.
5. During incidents, shelter in place. If evacuation is necessary, we can find and inform you. Be prepared to evacuate.

The Reynolds Fire Department needs your co-operation. This will help keep you, your neighbours and all fire fighters safe, before and during an emergency.
