Alternative watering systems for dugouts, waterways, alternative land use, water retention, rain gardens, abandoned well sealing, well head remediation etc.

**A PERMIT IS REQUIRED FOR:** Detached Accessory Building ie. garage, shed, gazebo etc over 108 sq ft, temporary structures larger than 900 sq ft, demolitions, new house, attached garage or carport, electrical, plumbing, decks, home based business, wood stove/fireplace, additions, wheelchair ramps, basement development, and foundation repairs.  
**Projects that normally DO NOT require a Permit:** replacing shingles with the same material, replacing doors and windows with the same size (includes security bars on windows), replacing stucco or siding with the same material, painting, patching, decorating, installing cabinets or shelves. **Although a permit may not be required, it is still necessary for these projects to comply with the building code and applicable zoning requirements. Under the authority of the current building by-law a fee of double the current rate is applicable if a permit is not applied for.**

Current taxes will be payable on or before October 30, 2020 or they will be subject to penalties of 1.25% on the first of each month. Please call for your current amount owing including penalties if the taxes are overdue. Please enclose the tax statement stub or indicate the Roll number(s) with your payment. Remittances should be made payable to the Rural Municipality of Reynolds and mailed to: PO Box 46, Hadashville, MB R0E 0X0. Under provincial legislation, the RM of Reynolds is given the responsibility to collect taxes for the local school boards. The RM of Reynolds does not set this rate. If you have any questions or concerns regarding the school tax rates, please call your school division.

### BOARD OF REVISION

The Board of Revision will sit on November 3, 2020 at 6:00 pm in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Office in Hadashville to hear applications.

The final date on which the applications must be received by the Secretary of the Board is October 12, 2020 at 12:00 pm. Prior to filing an appeal, you are encouraged to discuss the matter with the Provincial Municipal Assessment Branch in Steinbach at (204) 326-9896.

### EPTCA-EDUCATION PROPERTY TAX CREDIT

Once you have lived in your **primary residence** for one year, you can apply to have the EPTCA taken off your tax bill. The tax credit is up to a maximum of \$700.00. If it is not on your bill, you can apply to have it refunded on your Income Tax.
