TITLE: FIRE BANS

Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to define the process of calling Fire Bans in the RM of Reynolds in conjunction with By-Law 02/18.

Procedure:

1. a) The CAO, in discussion with the Fire Chief, the Public Works Manager, and the Wildfire Superintendent, will call a Fire Ban after one is in place on the Provincial Wildfire Site.
b) The CAO may call a Fire Ban if one is not in place on the Provincial Wildfire Site if deemed necessary.
2. The RM of Reynolds will place a Fire Ban Notice and an email bulletin on the website, stating it is effective immediately.


